SPECTATOR GUIDE

Spectator Safety

Spectators may watch International Rally New York only from designated Spectator Areas supervised by trained Safety Marshals and equipped with emergency radio communications and other emergency services. The access to each Spectator Area is along a separate access road and not over the Special Stage road. Spectators are prohibited from entering and walking along the Special Stage road. For your safety, please obey the instructions of Safety Marshals in the Spectator Areas.

Please drive safely and obey speed limits
We never race on public roads open to regular traffic

Spectator Area at Lundy Road and Roques Harbor Road

Welcome International Rally New York 2008!

The best rally drivers from the United States and from abroad will compete in this exciting event. The course is 360 miles long with 93 miles of Special Stages. International Rally New York 2008 is the final round of the United States Rally Championship. It also counts toward the New York Rally Championship. We are grateful to the Governments of the Town of Wawarsing, the Town of Walton, the Town of Tompkins, Ulster County Tourism, Sullivan County Visitors Association, the management of Ten Mile River Scout Reservation, local fire departments and emergency medical services, local business and civic organizations, residents and local businesses, sponsors, law enforcement personnel, countless volunteers and amateur radio operators for their support.

What is a Stage Rally?

It is a car rally with a number of Special Stages linked together by transit sections. The rally cars are typically small sedans such as Subaru Impreza or Mitsubishi Evo. On the Special Stages on public roads closed to civilian traffic, the rally cars start at one-minute intervals and race against the clock. On the transit sections, the rally cars drive in regular traffic and obey all traffic laws. If a competitor is observed speeding on a transit section, he is penalized and may be disqualified from the rally.
